

FOOTBALL GAME PROCEDURES

1. Arrive at school. Place your uniform and instruments in the appropriate rooms. Rehearse on the specified field. After rehearsal, make sure your instrument is taken to the truck to be loaded (you will be told when to do this). We will load the buses as they are ready. All students will travel on buses to the game.
2. Upon arrival we will unload buses and equipment. Listen for instructions.
3. When you leave your bus, get your instrument and get into block formation next to the buses.
4. March into stands; REMAIN STANDING until a Drum Major or the Director seats you.
5. REMAIN in FULL UNIFORM during entire game unless told by Band Director to do otherwise.
6. Behave as responsible and respectable members of the Lake Brantley High School Band. Swearing while in uniform is inappropriate. Smoking while with the band is not appropriate at any time.
7. Always pay attention to the Directors, Drum Majors, and the officers for instructions, music selection, etc.
8. After half time, THIRD QUARTER is usually free for getting food, cold drinks, or using the restrooms. Any students who were not dressed out appropriately for practices or were late to the rehearsal will lose this privilege.
9. DO NOT go to the other side of the field without authorized permission.
10. YOU MUST be in your seat, ready to play at the BEGINNING of FOURTH QUARTER.
11. No food or drinks will be allowed in the band stands at ANY time.
12. Make sure all of your equipment is secured before going on break. Do not leave instruments where they can be damaged.
13. Do not walk on seats, use the aisles only.
14. When playing in the stands, everyone must watch at all times in case cutoffs are necessary. When playing in the stands, stand at attention.
15. After the game we will march in cadence to the buses and reload the buses and equipment trucks. You are responsible for making sure your instrument gets placed in the trucks.
16. After loading is completed, roll will be called. It must be absolutely silent for roll to be taken.
17. Upon arrival at LBHS you must get your instrument from the truck, clean up, and stack your chair in either the band, chorus, or keyboard room. You are then able to leave.
